Dogs are not allowed on the club walks.

All walkers are responsible for their own safety and accept that they take part in walks at their own risk.

They should however:

- * Follow the walk leader's instructions.
- * Observe the Countryside Code.
- * Wear suitable footwear and clothing.
- * Carry spare clothing, food & safety equipment appropriate for the walk.
